## ***FAQ's and Commonly Asked Questions Studio 1091 club.***

### ***What is Studio 1091 and what does it mean?***

Studio 1091 is the 3D art club at the University of the Pacific. Fall 2010 was the first semester that the club was officially registered with ASUOP. The name includes the physical address of the studio where meetings, workshops, and other club events will be held. The studio is located at 1091 W. Mendocino Ave, Stockton, CA. Besides that convenience of having the address in the name, the name is also unique to the club while hitting points of clarity, professionalism, and identity.

### ***What does a 3D art club do?***

Initially, the club revolves around the idea of making art first. The club is also involved in attending and/or hosting lectures, workshops, and sales. We hope to create an atmosphere of creativity and enthusiasm for the arts.

### ***Where do you meet?***

The club meets in the CS Building that will hold a monthly meeting, which is encouraged to attend. There will be a mandatory demo/ rules discussion meeting **all** must attend.

### ***Where is the CS Building?***

The CS building, standing for Ceramics Studio Building, is located between the Baseball field and the Geosciences building. The physical address is 1091 W. Mendocino Ave.

### ***Is there a club fee?***

Yes, the club fee is: \$110 for individual sessions (Fall, Spring, or Summer) or \$300 for a year session, which includes Fall, Spring, and Summer. A membership request form will also need to be filled out.

### ***Do I have to be an art major?***

No, you do not have to be an art major. The club is a way for those pursuing a career other than art to have a place to be creative.

***What if I have never made ceramics or have little knowledge of it?***

There will be students to assist you if you need help during the lab hours. If you need more help, then you can arrange a meeting with a lab assistant for a group demo.

***If I am taking a ceramics class this semester, do I still have to pay a studio fee?***

Please be aware that if you are enrolled in ARTS 035, ARTS 133, or ARTS 135, the fee does not apply to you since you have already paid the lab studio fee.

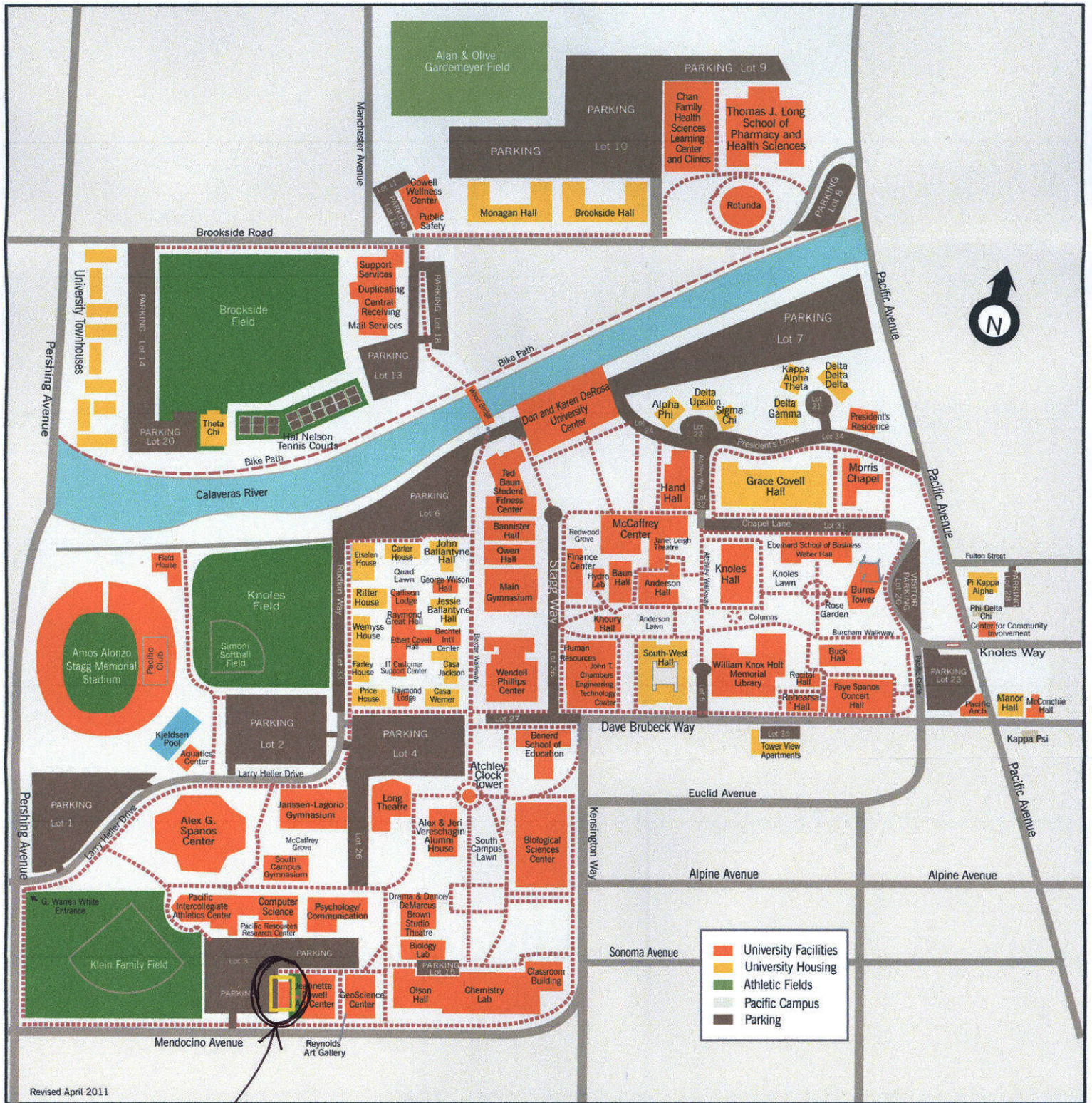
